

13. Copper Globe (Thursday, Friday)

(Fridays ride is a Geocaching event. A list of cache sites will be sent to registered riders.)

- This ride begins at Justensen Flats (elevation 7000ft). You must trailer your ATV approximately 25 miles on gravel roads to the trail head. From there you will drop in to Devil Canyon and then climb out to Copper Globe mine and on to Link Flats Keep an eye out for wild horses and very outstanding scenery. There will also be a chance to do some Geocaching. You will enjoy breathtaking views along the trail.
This will be a "lazy ride".

14. BEHIND THE REEF (Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday)

- Because of the length, this ride must begin an hour earlier. Meet guides and ride starts at 7 a.m. You must trailer your ATV 45 miles to the trail head at Tan Seeps. From there you will travel to Temple Mountain and view the remnants of the uranium mining boom of the 1950's. From Temple Mountain you will follow Behind the Reef Trail to Hidden Splendor Mine then to Hondu Arch Country, up Red's Canyon and back to the trail head. **This ride is 50+/- miles of maintained roads and 20+/- miles of Intermediate and short areas of Advanced trails and is limited to 4 wheel drive machines ONLY! Extra fuel may be needed depending on your mileage, we suggest everyone carry extra just in case.**

15. LOST SPRING CANYON (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday)

- T This ride is on the northeast end of the San Rafael Swell (elevation 6000 feet). You must trailer your own ATV approximately 40 miles on gravel roads. This has very different scenery than in other places in the Swell. Mostly ATV trail and un-maintained roads. **This ride is rated Intermediate.**

16. SAN RAFAEL MERRY-GO-ROUND (Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday)

- This ride begins at Bellevue Flat (elevation 5550 ft.). It is a ride for those wanting a long fast (in places) ride. One section is the same as the Fix-it Pass ride. It includes a river crossing, great views, ancient Indian Petroglyphs, Dinosaur foot prints and much more. Bring extra gas as this ride is 65 plus miles long. **This ride is rated Intermediate.**

Please note that you will need to provide your own sack lunches while on the rides, except for the Ladies only ride.
